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Dear Parents/Guardians,

1. **Home-school cooperation to prevent Summer Influenza Season and Additional Measure on Temperature Monitoring**

The local seasonal influenza activity has continued to increase recently, indicating that Hong Kong has entered the 2025 summer influenza season. The community should heighten vigilance and take proper personal protection measures against influenza and other respiratory infections. With the start of the new school term, there has been a significant increase in influenza-like illness (ILI) outbreaks in schools. As schools are collective assembly places, infectious diseases such as influenza and other respiratory infections could be easily spread among people through their daily contacts. **Schools would actively check the body temperature of all students every day during this influenza season when they arrive at school so as to identify students with fever.**

Vaccination has been scientifically proven to be one of the most effective means to prevent severe cases of seasonal influenza and its complications. It also reduces the risks of in-patient admission and mortality due to seasonal influenza. Getting vaccinated well before the winter influenza season can effectively protect one's health and that of one's family. Besides receiving SIV for personal protection, students should maintain personal, hand and environmental hygiene against influenza and other respiratory infections. Measures on Prevention of Seasonal Influenza

1. Maintain hand hygiene, avoid touching one's eyes, mouth and nose;
2. Wash hands with liquid soap and water properly whenever possibly contaminated;
3. Cover the nose and mouth with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing. Dispose of soiled tissue paper properly into a lidded rubbish bin, and wash hands thoroughly afterwards;
4. Maintain good indoor ventilation;
5. Wear a mask properly, including performing hand hygiene before wearing and after removing a mask;
6. Wear a mask when getting into contact with persons with fever or respiratory symptoms; taking public transportation or staying at crowded places; and high risk persons should wear a surgical mask when visiting public place;
7. When having respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask, refrain from work or attending classes at school, avoid going to crowded places and seek medical advice promptly; and
8. Build up good body immunity by having a balanced diet, exercise regularly, take adequate rest, do not smoke and avoid overstress.

Global Classroom Programme - Chongqing and Chengdu Study Tour 2025 (Applicable to S.4 to S.5)

1. Aims:
 - 1.1 To learn about the history and culture of Chongqing and Chengdu
 - 1.2 To understand the opportunities and challenges brought by the development of Chongqing and Chengdu
2. Date: 3rd Dec (Wed) to 8th Dec (Mon) (6 days 5 nights)
3. Target: S.4 to S.5 students (priority will be given to students taking Chinese History, BAFS or Economics)
4. Quota: 18 students (Selection procedures will be implemented if the number of applications exceed the quota of the programme.)
5. Fee:
 - 5.1 HK\$3,500 (The original tour fee was \$5,500, with return air tickets sponsored by Hong Kong Airlines)
 - 5.2 The tour fee includes airfare, taxes, fuel surcharges, insurance, local transportation, and accommodation, but Visa fee and personal consumption are excluded.
 - 5.3 HK\$1,500 will be granted if the applicant is the recipient of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance or full-grant of Student Financial Assistance. HK\$750 will be granted if the applicant is the recipient of half-grant of Student Financial Assistance.
 - 5.4 If students are absent without proper reasons, all fees will not be returned and full costs \$5,500 will be charged.
