1 S3 After-school Study Class Arrangements

To enhance students' learning efficiency and consolidate their learning, the School will arrange after-school study classes for S3 students. For details, please refer to Attachment 1. Before returning to school for after-school study classes, students must have checked their **body temperature**, have performed **the rapid antigen test (RAT)** and have taken a photograph of the test result (Only students obtaining negative test results are allowed to return to school for lessons; students who have tested positive must not return to school). They must bring the "Record Sheet for Body Temperature and Rapid Antigen Test", signed by their parent/guardian to the School. The School opens at 9:00 am on Saturdays for this activity.

Students may be asked to present a photograph of the test result. The RAT and checking of body temperature must be done in the morning every day. Parents/guardians, please ensure that your children have completed the RAT every day before returning to school and that they bring the "Record Sheet for Body Temperature and Rapid Antigen Test".

2.5 Remarks:

- 2.5.1 Since the session will be held in the form of a Zoom meeting and face-to-face session, the results of the mock subject selection will be distributed to your child by the class teacher on 13th June.
- 2.5.2 When attending the Parents' Night online, parents are reminded to use your child's class, class number and full name in Chinese/ English to log in to Zoom for identification.
- 2.5.3 Parents who **physically attend** for participation in this meeting are reminded to pay attention to the following details:
 - 2.5.3.1 You are required to complete the "Declaration Form on Health" (see Attachment 2) and submit it to the teachers concerned before the meeting.
 - 2.5.3.2 You must have received at least two doses of COVID-19 vaccine to obtain the "Vaccine Pass" for persons aged 18 or above unless you are exempted. You must have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine to obtain the "Vaccine Pass" for persons aged 12 to 17 unless you are exempted.
 - 2.5.3.3 Circumstances which have been granted exemptions include children aged under 12 with a "COVID-19 Vaccination Medical Exemption Certificate".
 - 2.5.3.4 Under the Vaccine Pass arrangement, except for scenarios which have been deemed exempt, all persons entering or remaining on any specified premises are required to carry an electronic version or a paper copy of their COVID-19 vaccination record or Exemption Certificate, and actively scan the school's QR code. You are required to present to the person-in-charge of the School your vaccination record or Exemption Certificate and the relevant QR code, including that saved in "LeaveHomeSafe" mobile application or shown on mobile applications such as "iAM Smart" or "eHealth", or the QR code shown on your paper vaccination record.
 - 2.5.3.5 Should parents or students have any inquires, please write your questions on the reply slip or ask them on the day, and the class teacher(s) will endeavour to answer them at the meeting.
