### **1 S3 Class Arrangements after Examination Period**

S3 Second Term Examinations will be completed on 30<sup>th</sup> June. Classes will resume as usual from 4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> July. The S3 bridging course will be conducted from 13<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> July. Please refer to Attachment 1 of Parent's Notice 21060 for details. The "Library Easy Reading Scheme" will be conducted by students at home from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> July.

### **2 Home/School Co-operation Prevention of Communicable Disease**

The Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health has recently received increased reports of institutional outbreaks of "Upper Respiratory Tract Infection" (URTI). As schools are places of collective assembly, infectious diseases can easily spread among people through daily contact. In this regard, the School will reinforce preventive measures and ensure vigilance concerning students and staff with active symptoms so as to mitigate the impact of URTI.

Under the guidance of the CHP, the School has adopted the following measures:

- 2.1 The CHP of the Department of Health and the Education Bureau remind schools to reinforce preventive measures on the campus so as to prevent outbreaks of respiratory tract infection including COVID-19. Schools should check the body temperature of all students daily when they arrive at school so as to identify students with fever. Staff should also check their temperature before work every day. It is of prime importance that staff and students with fever (oral temperature higher than 37.5°C, or ear temperature higher than 38°C) should not be allowed to attend school, regardless of the presence/absence of respiratory symptoms. Accompanied by their parent(s), the students concerned should consult a doctor promptly.
- 2.2 Since the symptoms of influenza-like illness (ILI) and URTI are similar to those of COVID-19, to be prudent, the schools with ILI or URTI outbreaks will be covered in the compulsory testing notice (CTN) to exclude the possibility of COVID-19 infection. Such schools are required to suspend teaching activities for cleaning for 5 days. All students and staff are required to receive COVID-19 testing under CTN and must receive a negative test result before they are allowed to go back to school after the resumption of normal school days.

In addition, we would like to remind parents to exercise good hygiene practices at home, and follow the guidelines provided by the CHP for prevention of upper respiratory tract infection:

- Surgical masks can prevent the transmission of respiratory viruses from infected persons. It is essential for persons who are symptomatic (even if experiencing only mild symptoms) to wear a surgical mask;
- Wear a surgical mask when taking public transport or staying in crowded places. It is important to wear a mask properly, including paying attention to hand hygiene before wearing and after removing a mask;
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth;

- Wash hands with liquid soap and water properly whenever there is the possibility of contamination;
- When hands are not visibly soiled, clean them with 70 to 80 per cent alcohol-based handrub;
- Cover the nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing; Dispose of soiled tissue paper properly in a lidded rubbish bin and wash hands thoroughly afterwards;
- When experiencing respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask, refrain from work or attending class at school, avoid going to crowded places and seek medical advice promptly; and
- Maintain a balanced diet, exercise regularly, take adequate rest, do not smoke and avoid increased stress.


