## 1 LSS Goodwill Campaign - "Sharing Resources, Sharing Love"

Under the ever-changing conditions of the pandemic, the school has put to good use the masks and Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) kits donated by alumnus Mr. Ngan Chan Chun and community welfare agencies. Their donations helped ease the financial burden on parents. The school will also prepare adequate masks and RATs. These resources will be distributed to particular students from S1 to S6 (see Remarks) after school in the hall on 13<sup>th</sup> October.

Remarks: If a student has recovered from COVID-19 and has submitted relevant government-issued certificates to the school (e.g. quarantine order, vaccination medical exemption certificate, QR code of recovery record, etc.), he/she is not required to undergo the RAT for three months starting from the date of recovery (excluding students who still display symptoms), and therefore it is not necessary for him/her to collect RAT kits from the school hall for the following week.


