5 S6 Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS)

To assist S6 students with using the JUPAS online application system, the school will organise the Unique Goal Project on 21st October which will include a briefing session on the JUPAS online application system. Hong Kong students sitting for the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Exam can apply for the following programmes through JUPAS:

- 6.1 University Grants Committee (UGC) funded programmes
 - 6.1.1 UGC-funded full-time degree programmes offered by the following 8 universities: City University of Hong Kong (CityU), Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU), Lingnan University (LingU), The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK), The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK), The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) and The University of Hong Kong (HKU);
 - 6.1.2 UGC-funded full-time associate degree programmes offered by CityU;
 - 6.1.3 UGC-funded full-time higher diploma programmes offered by EdUHK;
 - 6.1.4 UGC-funded full-time higher diploma programmes offered by PolyU;
- 6.2 Self-financing programmes
 - 6.2.1 Self-financing full-time bachelor's degree programmes offered by HKMU; and

6 S6 School Nominations Direct Admission Scheme

The School Nominations Direct Admission Scheme (SNDAS) is introduced with the aim of recognising the talent of local secondary students, for this may not be fully assessed by the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination. It is a 'programme-student matching exercise' in essence that provides opportunities for secondary students who have demonstrated exceptional talents and interests in specific disciplines / areas to be considered for direct admission to local universities. The eight UGC-funded universities have designated a total of around 146 publicly-funded undergraduate programmes to participate in SNDAS in the 2022/23 academic year. 7.1 Quota: Each local secondary school has a quota of **two nominations** for nominating students with exceptional talents and interests in specific disciplines / areas. Each student nominee can apply for admission to **one** designated UGC-funded undergraduate programme participating in SNDAS.

7.2 Procedures:

Students may in person submit the completed 'application form of Principal's Recommendation Scheme JUPAS (CGC_form_001)' and copies of relevant supporting documents to Mr. Ho Cho

Ming (Rm511) on or before 4th November, 2022. (You may collect the application form at the School Office.)

7.3 Interview :

Interviews will be arranged between 7th and 18th November. The results will be posted on the Careers Committee Bulletin Board near the Principal's Office on or before 30th November.

7.4 Remarks:

- 7.4.1 Given that the SNDAS will be implemented in parallel with the JUPAS route, students nominated for SNDAS should submit their JUPAS application at the same time. Successful nominees will **NOT** be considered for other Principal's recommendation schemes.
- 7.4.2 Student nominees **MUST** include the chosen SNDAS-participating undergraduate programme as **one of their 20 JUPAS programme choices**; student nominees who fail to do so **will not be considered by the participating universities for SNDAS**.
- 7.4.3 Participating universities may also require student nominees to include their chosen SNDAS-participating programme as one of their JUPAS Band A programme choices. Please study the specific admission requirements for each participating programme.
- 7.4.4 Participating universities will arrange **interviews for ALL students nominated for SNDAS** to assess the suitability of the nominees for specific programmes between **January and early June 2023**. Written / practical assessments may also be arranged.
- 7.4.5 Participating universities will make firm offers to successful SNDAS student nominees in June 2023, prior to the release of the 2023 HKDSE Examination results.
- 7.4.6 **Successful nominees MUST** decide whether to accept the offer **BEFORE the release of the 2023 HKDSE Examination results**. Once accepted, the firm offer will be **binding** and the nominees **WILL NOT** be considered / accepted by other programmes regardless of their HKDSE Examination results. **Their JUPAS application will automatically be removed from the JUPAS application system**. Successful nominees who have accepted the firm offer will commence study for their chosen programme in September 2023.
- 7.4.7 For **unsuccessful nominees** (i.e. those who did not receive / rejected the SNDAS offer), **their JUPAS applications will continue to be processed** and be considered by the JUPAS-participating institutions for admission to their programmes following the release of the 2023 HKDSE Examination results.
