Under the ever-changing conditions of the pandemic, the school has put to good use the masks and Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) kits donated by alumnus Mr. Ngan Chan Chun and community welfare agencies. Their donations helped ease the financial burden on parents. The school will also prepare adequate masks and RATs. These resources will be distributed to particular students from S1 to S6 (see Remarks) at 3:45p.m.-4:15p.m. in the hall on 5th December. Remarks: If a student has recovered from COVID-19 and has submitted relevant government-issued certificates to the school (e.g. quarantine order, vaccination medical exemption certificate, QR code of recovery record, etc.), he/she is not required to undergo the RAT for three months starting from the date of recovery (excluding students who still display symptoms), and therefore it is not necessary for him/her to collect RAT kits from the school hall for the following week.

To leave students with a life-long memory of their secondary school life, School Photograph Day is scheduled for 6th December, 2022 (Tue, A2). All students are reminded to wear the school winter uniform. All classes will be arranged to take the class photos. S.6 students will take graduation photos. 4 2023/24 "Neighbourhood First · Rice-Giving Scheme"

To ease the burden of Hong Kong low-income earners by providing them material support and care, Au Bak Ling Charity Trust ("ABLCT") and the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups ("HKFYG") has established the 'Rice-Giving Scheme'. Approved family applicant is eligible to collect a pack of 5 kg rice each month or every two months (odd-numbered months). Please see Attachment 2 for details.


6 Distribution of School Publication "Lutheran Newsletter"

2023/24 “Neighbourhood First · Rice-Giving Scheme”**1 Background**

The scheme also allows youth volunteers to help distribute rice packs, which provides them with opportunities to support and care about people in-need in the community. Over 50,000 families in need have benefited from the scheme since its establishment.

2 Scheme Details:

- 2.1 Family applicant, whose application is approved, is eligible to collect a pack of 5 kg rice each month or every two months (odd-numbered months) respectively;
- 2.2 If an eligible applicant, whose application is approved, is physically capable, he or she must collect the rice pack according to the designated time, date and rice station location; otherwise, he or she will be regarded as self-withdrawn from the Scheme;
- 2.3 The HKFYG will arrange the rice collection location according to the preferences stated in the application form as best as possible and the HKFYG reserves the right for the final decision;
- 2.4 The eligibility for the collection of rice lasts for one year, from April 2023 to March 2024;
- 2.5 Deadline of application submission: 6th December 2022 (Tue).

3 Application Eligibility:

- 3.1 Applicant must be a Hong Kong resident from a low-income family or living alone;
- 3.2 The total income of the household must be equal to or less than 75% of the median household income of Hong Kong as per data released by the Census and Statistics Bureau. Different median household incomes of Hong Kong will be adopted according to the number of member(s) in the household (using the statistical data (E031) released by the government in the second season as a reference):

Respective median/household	1 person	2 people	3 people	4 people	5 people	6 people or more
75% of Median monthly household income (HKD)	7,350	14,925	24,375	32,250	41,325	44,175

- 3.3 Each household can only submit one application and must have a referral made by a registered social worker;
- 3.4 Applicant who is not a recipient of the Comprehensive Social Security (CSSA) Scheme or other periodical financial support will receive priority handling of his or her application;
- 3.5 The duration of assistance of this Scheme will not exceed 1 years, unless all family members are elderly or some family members receive Disability Allowance;
- 3.6 Eligible applicant whose application is approved cannot receive any rice packs distributed by other scheme or organization from April 2023 to March 2024.

4 Assessment Criteria:

- 4.1 The total income and the per capita income of the household;
- 4.2 The total number of member(s) in the household and the number of dependent member(s) (e.g., full-time teenage student and the elderly);
- 4.3 Other factors of consideration, including the health condition and living environment of the applicant and/or his or her family member(s), etc;
- 4.4 First-time applicants will receive priority on their applications.

5 Measures to Prevent the Abuse of the Scheme

- 5.1 This Scheme is specially designed for low-income earners and families, the HKFYG is committed to the prevention of fraudulent conduct and situations of abuse;
- 5.2 All rice packs distributed by this Scheme are specially designated to support the underprivileged. Reselling is forbidden. If any action of reselling is discovered, the HKFYG will disqualify the applicant from joining the Scheme forthwith;

- 5.3 The HKFYG may visit the households with approved application randomly. If it is discovered and confirmed that the applicant has committed fraudulent conduct, the HKFYG instantly disqualify the applicant from the Scheme.
- 5.4 If the eligible applicant fails to provide valid reasons and fail to collect the rice pack according to the specific time and date arrangements for 3 times, he or she will be automatically regarded as withdrawn from the Scheme. The HKFYG will terminate his or her qualification of rice collection and refer the case to the referral social worker.
- 5.5 The quota for the home delivery service is limited. The HKFYG will approve families in need according to the Assessment Criteria.
- 6 Application Procedures:

- 6.2 The School Development Committee will review applications and notify successful applicants later. Applications must hand in the hard copies of household income certificates provided by the family members living together (Application without providing this document will not be approved) and declare that all submitted information is true and correct. Eligibility will be terminated for any incorrect or untrue information submitted.
