### 3 S3 Senior Secondary Subject Opinion Collection

The school offers three categories of subjects, namely DSE elective subjects (Category A) and applied learning subjects (Category B). In order to provide your child with a suitable medium of instruction and appropriate elective subjects for their senior secondary study, the school has arranged for S3 students (S4 in 2023-2024) to complete the subject opinion survey. This will enable the school to bridge the gap between the junior and senior syllabi with explicit curriculum links between the two. Our goal is for students to have adequate time to prepare for their senior secondary studies and master the examination skills necessary to achieve good results. When completing the survey form (distributed by class teachers), please consider your child's Chinese and English ability, academic results (e.g. the Unified Test of the first semester) and learning interests. The completed form should be returned to the class teacher on or before 12<sup>th</sup> December (Mon) for collection. After taking into consideration of each student's English ability, academic results in relevant subjects and the number of students enrolled in each course, the school will make optimal arrangements. Results will be announced later.

### **Information about the Athletic Meet**

Please pay attention to the following:

1. Date: 13<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 (Tuesday and Wednesday)
2. Time: 8 a.m. to around 1:30 p.m.
3. Venue: Sham Shui Po Sports Ground
4. **Arrangements for Opening and Closing Ceremonies**
  - 4.1 Students have to arrive at the sports ground by 8 a.m. and gather on the track in front of the spectator stand. Class teachers will then take roll call.
  - 4.2 The opening, closing and prize-giving ceremonies will be held at the sports ground. During the day, students will sit according to their houses.
  - 4.3 The prize-giving ceremony will be held at 12:30 p.m. on 14<sup>th</sup> December. Parents are welcome to join the event. Parents who wish to attend the event should state so in the reply slip.
5. **Dress Code and Attendance**
  - 5.1 All students have to wear P.E. uniforms (According to the sports ground rules, students have to wear sports shoes). Students of uniformed groups like Hong Kong Road Safety Association and Red Cross are allowed to wear their group uniforms if they are carrying out their duties on the day. Other performance groups are only allowed to change into their respective uniforms after entering the sports ground. Students in violation of any rules of the dress code will be subject to punishments according to the school's regulations.
  - 5.2 Attendance will be taken in the morning. Students will be counted as present only if their attendance is recorded by their class teachers. For those who are ill and cannot attend the athletic meet, they have to apply for sick leave to the Head of the Discipline Department and present the medical certificates within 2 days after normal school days resume. In addition, students who wish to apply for casual leave to the Head of the Discipline Committee must do so in advance. Absence without reason will be considered truancy.
6. **Discipline**
  - 6.1 Activities that are unrelated to sports (e.g. reading newspapers, reading books, reading comics, reading magazines, listening to the radio or music) are prohibited. The items will be confiscated if they are discovered by prefects or teachers. They will only be returned on receipt of a parent's letter. Newspapers, books, comics and magazines may not be returned depending on the circumstances. The staircases on both sides of the spectator stand are to be used only for entering the competition venues while the one behind is only for ascension.
  - 6.2 The Venue Cleaning Competition will be held during the athletic meet. House supervisors, tutors and members will work with the students to keep the venue clean.
  - 6.3 No eating is allowed in the spectator stand, on the track or in the grass area (except for drinks delivered to helpers). Students are allowed to eat or drink at the tuck shop only. Loitering at the tuck shop is prohibited. Additionally, students are not allowed to eat chewing gum or takeaway.
  - 6.4 Students should not run or block the aisles of the spectator stand. Non-helpers are not allowed to stay at the competition venues.
7. **Safety**
  - 7.1 Only secondary students having received three doses of COVID-19 vaccine and primary students having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine for more than 14 days are allowed to have mask-off activities.
  - 7.2 Students should not bring large amounts of money or any valuable items. They should take good care of their personal belongings.
  - 7.3 Students are encouraged to use footbridges and zebra crossings when they go out for lunch and return to the sports ground. Do not jaywalk.
