### 5 **Invitation for eHealth (醫健通)Registration (Via School Enrolment)**

Developed by the Government and rolled out in 2016, the Electronic Health Record Sharing System (eHealth) provides a territory-wide and secure electronic platform that allows authorised healthcare providers (e.g. hospitals, clinics) in the public and private sectors, with registrant's consent, to view and share Health participant's electronic health records (eHRs) within the sharable scope on a "need-to-know" and "patient-under-care" basis. The eHealth mobile application (the App) was launched in 2021 to enable users to view parts of their own eHRs, obtain useful health information and actively manage their own health, etc.

eHealth has gradually covered records of vaccinations under different Government Vaccination Schemes. Riding on the invitation to the 2023/24 Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Programme (the SIV Programme) by the Department of Health (DH), we would like to encourage parents and guardians as well as students aged 16 or above to register Health for their children or themselves free of charge and voluntarily, with a view to enjoying the benefits, including access to vaccination records via the App to save their time in managing paper vaccination records. This also enables the establishment of personal, lifelong and privacy-protected eHRs for continued healthcare services.

If parents are interested in registering your children for eHealth through the school, please complete the reply slip and consent form on or before 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2023, and return them to the class teacher.

## **“Cold Water Delivery” Programme**

### 1 Aims

- 1.1 Help students and their families get through the difficulties in their lives.
- 1.2 Through experiencing the salvation, love, and tenderness of Jesus Christ, the true God of the universe, students will be empowered to overcome difficulties and adversities, face challenges with confidence and passion, and achieve their dreams.
- 1.3 Inspire students to stick to their faith in the ever-changing environment and become believers who honor God and benefit others with good spirituality and godliness in school, family, church, and society.

### **Home-school cooperation to prevent seasonal influenza**

The local seasonal influenza activity has continued to increase in the past few weeks and has exceeded the seasonal epidemic threshold, indicating that Hong Kong has entered influenza season. Schools/institutions are places where groups gather, and infectious diseases can easily spread through close contact between people. Schools are urged to be vigilant, pay attention to the health of students and staff, and strengthen preventive measures to reduce the risk of seasonal influenza.

Therefore, according to the instructions of the Centre for Health Protection, in order to prevent the spread of seasonal influenza, the school will measure the body temperature of all students arriving at the school every day to identify students with fever. In addition, vaccination is one of the most effective ways to prevent seasonal influenza and its complications.

Besides receiving seasonal influenza vaccination as early as possible for personal protection, the following measures are advised to prevent influenza and respiratory tract infections:

- Surgical masks can prevent transmission of respiratory viruses from ill persons. It is essential for persons who are symptomatic (even if experiencing mild symptoms) to wear a surgical mask;
- For high-risk persons (e.g. persons with underlying medical conditions or persons who are immunocompromised), wear a surgical mask when taking public transport or staying in crowded places. It is important to wear a mask properly, including performing hand hygiene procedures before wearing and after removing a mask;
- Avoid touching one's eyes, mouth and nose;
- Wash hands with liquid soap and water properly whenever possibly contaminated;
- When hands are not visibly soiled, clean them with 70 to 80 per cent alcohol-based hand rub;
- Cover the nose and mouth with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing. Dispose of soiled tissue paper properly into a lidded rubbish bin, and wash hands thoroughly afterwards;
- Maintain good indoor ventilation;
- When experiencing respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask, refrain from work or attending classes at school, avoid going to crowded places and seek medical advice promptly; and
- Build up good body immunity by having a balanced diet, exercise regularly, take adequate rest, do not smoke and avoid overstress.
