1. Eligibility:
 - 1.1 **All** LSS students
2. Application procedures:
 - 2.1 For students supported by CSSA/TA schemes, please attach photocopies of relevant certificates. (Please submit the photocopies of relevant certificates to the class teachers. If these documents have been submitted in September, students are not required to re-submit them.)
 - 2.2 For students **who are not** supported by CSSA/TA schemes, are facing special financial difficulties and need to be approved by the school for individual projects; parents can attach a letter briefly describing the family situation for approval. (Please submit the letter to the class teacher.)
 - 2.3 Students participate in courses or activities and pay fees as usual. (Before registration, students may inquire with the teacher(s) in charge whether the activity is subsidised.)
 - 2.4 At the completion of courses or activities, the relevant teacher(s) will evaluate the attendance rate and performance. Students with a poor attendance rate or performance may not be subsidised.
 - 2.5 At the end of each semester, the School Development Committee will summarise the records of each student and transfer the allowance of the prepaid program to his / her parent's account.
