1 Home/School Cooperation to Prevent Seasonal Influenza

Local seasonal influenza activity has continued to increase in the past few weeks and has exceeded the seasonal epidemic threshold, indicating that Hong Kong has entered influenza season. Currently, the predominant circulating virus is influenza A(H3). Schools/institutions are places where groups gather, and infectious diseases can easily spread through close contact between people. Schools are urged to be vigilant, pay attention to the health of students and staff, and strengthen preventive measures to reduce the risk of seasonal influenza. Home/School Cooperation to Prevent Seasonal Influenza

According to the instructions of the Center for Health Protection, in order to prevent the spread of seasonal influenza, the school will measure the body temperature of all students arriving at the school every day to identify students with fever. In addition, vaccination is one of the most effective ways to prevent seasonal influenza and its complications. Besides receiving seasonal influenza vaccination as early as possible for personal protection, the following measures are advised to prevent influenza and respiratory tract infections:

- Maintain hand hygiene, avoid touching one's eyes, mouth and nose;
- Wash hands with liquid soap and water properly whenever possibly contaminated;
- Cover the nose and mouth with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing. Dispose of soiled tissue paper properly into a lidded rubbish bin, and wash hands thoroughly afterwards;
- Maintain good indoor ventilation;
- It is important to wear a mask properly, including performing hand hygiene before wearing and after removing a mask;
- When experiencing respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask, refrain from work or attending classes at school, avoid going to crowded places and seek medical advice promptly;
- Wear a surgical mask when coming into contact with persons with fever or respiratory symptoms;
- The public should also wear a surgical mask when taking public transportation or staying at crowded places;
- High risk persons should wear a surgical mask when visiting public places; and
- Build up good body immunity by having a balanced diet, exercising regularly, and taking adequate rest. Refrain from smoking and avoid overstress.
