## S.6 Study Room Arrangements – School Rules (Applicable to S.6)

1 Preparation before arriving at school

1.1 Students are required to dress properly and neatly at school according to the school's rules and regulations. Students must wear school uniform and no PE uniform is allowed.

2 Procedure after arriving at school

- 2.1 Students must sign in and study at the library (the opening hours will be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.).
- 2.2 Due to limited seating in the library, the library staff or teachers will notify S.6 students to study in the designated classrooms in case there are no more vacant seats. However, the designated classrooms are only open from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and S.6 students can study in the library from 3:30 to 6:00 p.m.

2.3 Students must sign out at the library before leaving school.

3 Rules

3.1 Be quiet in the library/ designated classroom(s), maintain a clean environment and keep personal belongings safe.

3.2 Students are only allowed to study in the library/designated classroom(s).

3.3 Students who cause issues during the study leave (e.g.: walking around the campus during lesson time, or breaking the school rules) will not be allowed to come back to school for self-study purposes.
