**ELCHK LSS 65<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration and Social Science Week Activity:**  
**"Precious Treasures, Xi Zhen Heritage: Chinese Cultural Relics Exhibition"**

Thanks to the generosity of collectors from Xi Zhen Hui She Limited, more than 80 precious cultural relics have been loaned, including items such as a bronze jue from the Shang Dynasty, a tricolor seven-star plate from the Tang Dynasty, a gold and silver plate from the Liao Dynasty owned by Prince Han De Rang, dragon robes and imperial edicts from the Qing Dynasty, and more. Each item is of great value and significance, and they will be displayed on our school campus for a 12-day exhibition. The opening and closing ceremonies will feature a special lecture by Mr. Mark Li, the chairman of Xi Zhen Hui She Limited, who will share the historical, cultural, and artistic value of the cultural relics along with important archaeological insights. It will be a great opportunity from which teachers and students both will benefit. Additionally, our school has arranged an archaeological experience activity during the closing ceremony, allowing students to excavate artifacts using Luoyang shovels and experience the joy of archaeology. **Global Classroom Programme: Citizenship and Social Development – Sichuan Study Tour**  
**(Applicable to S.4 and S.5)**

1. Aims: It will allow students to personally visit Chengdu, Sichuan and through a variety of experiential activities, they will be able to appreciate the achievements of our country in different aspects such as economy, technology, ecological conservation, and cultural heritage protection, enhancing the students' national identity.
2. Date: 7<sup>th</sup> July (Sun) to 13<sup>th</sup> July (Sat) (7 days/6 nights)
3. Target: S.4 to S.5 students
4. Quota: 18 students
5. Organizing Agency: iTourStudy (Hong Kong) Limited
6. Fee and Subsidy Amount:
  - 6.1 HK\$8,023, which will be fully subsidized by the school (please refer to the remarks for subsidy conditions).
  - 6.2 Tour fee, accommodation, transportation fee and insurance are included, but visa fee and personal consumption are excluded.
  - 6.3 If students are absent without proper reason, no fees will be returned and the amount subsidized by the school (\$8,023) will be charged.

7/7 (Sun) HK – Chengdu (Flight)	Arrive at Chengdu Evening: Watch [Sichuan Opera Face Changing Performance]
8/7 (Mon) Chengdu – Xichang	Going to Xichang, passing through [Qionghai National Wetland Park] and Liangshan Yi Autonomous Prefecture, understanding the local ecology and experiencing the [Liangshan Yi ethnic style]
9/7 (Tue) Xichang	Go to [Xichang Satellite City], visit the Xichang Satellite Launch Center launch site, the Chang'e Project exhibition hall, etc, and participate in research and study experience activities
10/7 (Wed) Xichang – Chengdu	Visit [Dujiangyan Scenic Area]
11/7 (Thu) Chengdu	Go to [China Giant Panda Protection Research Center] ('Wolong Shenshuping Base' or 'Dujiangyan Base'), visit the China Giant Panda Garden built with the support of Hong Kong people, and become a [Panda Volunteer]. Visit [Jinli Old Street] [Wuhou Temple]
12/7 (Fri) Chengdu	Visit [Chengdu EMU Section Comprehensive Building] to learn about EMU knowledge. Go to Deyang to visit [Sanxingdui Museum] to understand the results of Sanxingdui archaeology"
13/7 (Sat) Chengdu – HK (Flight)	Take a flight back to Hong Kong

  - 9.1 Interested students should complete and return the reply slip to the class teacher on or before 19<sup>th</sup> April (Fri) (e-notice or paper-based notice).

  - 9.4 Successful applicants will receive a student registration form and student health declaration form, which should be filled out and returned to the school office.

If the Home Return Permit has expired, the student needs to renew it as soon as possible, which takes approximately two weeks for the renewal process
