Dear Parents/Guardians,

1. Second Term Examination Arrangements

The Second Term Examination will take place from 6th June (Fri) to 20th June (Fri). Details of the examination arrangements are shown in Attachments. Please encourage your child to be well-prepared in order to obtain the best results. Furthermore, please pay attention to the following items:

- 1.1 Students are required to tap their student ID cards before 8:00 a.m., otherwise they will be considered late.
- 1.2 Students must go directly to the examination rooms once they arrive at school for quiet revision. They must keep silent while waiting for the examination to commence.
- 1.3 In the event that any student has forgotten to bring their student ID card, that student needs to bring his/her student handbook to Room 207 to verify his/her identity. Under these circumstances, the examination WILL NOT be delayed and the student will not be given extra time for the examination.
- 1.4 Regarding absence or lateness without reason; 0 marks may be given for that subject.
- 1.5 Before the commencement of an examination, students are reminded to take the battery from their mobile phones (if possible) to ensure that no sound will be emitted. The alarm function of the mobile phone or any devices with an alarm function (including electronic watches) should not be in stand-by mode. You may be subject to a penalty according to the school regulations if your mobile phone or the alarm rings during an examination.
- 1.6 If the child cannot attend an examination because of illness or any special reasons, the parent must apply for leave to the School by phone call on that morning. Only after the student carries out the leave application procedures upon his/her return to school (and presentation of a medical certificate for sick leave to Mr. Ko, the Vice Dean of Studies, at Room 301), will special arrangements for the examination be considered.
- 1.7 Special arrangements for the absence will be considered only if the student approaches Mr. Ko at Room 301 by 29th May (Thu).
- 1.8 If the Education Bureau announces suspension of classes because of adverse weather conditions, all the examinations scheduled for that day will be rearranged. Please visit the School website: http://www.lss.edu.hk
 - for detailed information of arrangements.
- 1.9 If a student is absent from the lessons of a particular subject for over one-eighth of the total lessons (including sick leave and casual leave) in each term, he/she will not be allowed to attend the examination and 0 marks will be given for that subject (except for students who receive exemption approval from the Principal in advance).
- 1.10 Please refer to P.14-15 of the student handbook for other examination regulations.
- 1.11 Promotion requirements
 - 1.11.1 S.1 to S.3 students will not be allowed to be promoted if they cannot achieve a pass in the overall results of Chinese, English and Maths; or their Conduct has been determined to be unsatisfactory.
 - 1.11.2 S.4 to S.5 students will not be allowed to be promoted if they cannot achieve a pass in the overall results of Chinese, English, Maths, Citizenship and Social Development; or their Conduct has been determined to be unsatisfactory.
 - 1.11.3 For details, please refer to P.15 of the student handbook.
