5. Pilot Scheme on Other Languages for Junior Secondary Students (Applicable to S.1 to S.3)

To align with the Pilot Scheme on Other Languages for Junior Secondary Students launched by the Education Bureau (EDB), our school will offer Elementary Japanese course and Elementary Korean course for students in S.1 to S.3 during the 2025-2026 school year. To enhance students' interest and capabilities in learning other languages, enrich their learning experiences, enhance their international competitiveness, and strengthen the transition of junior form students to other language learning in senior form.

The initial lesson time is Saturday mornings (9:00 a.m.-10:30 a.m. or 10:30 a.m.-12:00 n.n.) during the period from December 2025 to June 2026. Each lesson last for 1.5 hours, and the course consists of 16 lessons, totaling 24 hours of instruction. The exact class time will be announced later. The classes will take place in our classrooms, with a class size of 20-30 students per class. The instructors are professionally qualified tutors from an external organization.

Each student is limited to enrolling in only one of the courses. Should the number of applications exceed the limit, Secondary 3 students will be given priority for admission. Admitted students are required to fully attend all the lessons. If it crashes with the gathering of Uniform Groups, students will not be admitted to this course.
