4 Arrangements for Student Grant

4.1 To help alleviate the financial burden of educational expenses on parents, a one-off student grant of \$2,500 was provided in the 2019/20 school year for each secondary day-school, primary school and kindergarten student. For the 'Student Grant' Application, there are two forms: Form A and Form B:

4.1.1 **Form A** is a blank form (**applicable to students who have been newly admitted to a school in this school year or have transferred to another school**). Parents are reminded to refer to the reference on the website of the Education Bureau when filling in the application form.

4.1.2 **Form B** is pre-printed with the basic information of the student as well as that of the applicant (**applicable to students who have been promoted to the next class level in the same school**). In general, parents are only required to check the accuracy of the pre-printed information, by putting a '✓' in the confirmation box at the bottom part of the form and signing to confirm if there is no change in the information pre-printed. If some of the pre-printed information on Form B requires updating (information other than Student's Name in English, Name of Day-school and School Level), parents have to provide the amendment(s) in the space above the relevant information in BLOCK letters using **black or blue ball pen**, and **leave the confirmation box blank**.

4.1.3 If **Student's Name in English, Name of Day-school or School Level** pre-printed on **Form B** requires amendment, parents of the students concerned should use Form A for application.

4.2 Remarks:


4.2.1 Parents are required to provide full information of their bank account. Parents should refer to the monthly bank statement /passbook/ Attachment 2 'Common Bank Code List'. In case of doubt, you may check your bank account.

4.2.2 Parents should read carefully the 'Notes to Complete this Form' and the 'Declaration' before completing the 'Student Grant' Application Form. The completed 'Student Grant' Application Form should be returned to class teachers on or before 11th October, 2021. The School will stamp the School chop on each 'Student Grant' Application Form to confirm the student concerned is a currently enrolled student.
